

## Guidelines for Illustrations

- Please note: The author is responsible for the acquisition of the image rights (open access, unlimited rights, PDF, HTML, and XML format) for publication in Journal of Black Opera and Music Theatre.
- When submitting a manuscript, please send the intended illustrations as image files (JPG, PNG or TIFF) as well as the captions incl. credits in your Word file to the editorial team (Journal of Black Opera and Music Theatre). For larger files, please use a filehosting-service like [Swiss Transfer](#), [WeTransfer](#) or similar.
- Please adapt the captions to the following guidelines prior to submission, particularly concerning formatting and citation style. Thank you!

Information about the illustrations:

- Image quality: The quality standard of the journal requires a minimum resolution of 300 dpi. The editorial office reserves the right not to publish illustrations of insufficient quality.
- Colour: If possible and desired, illustrations are set in colour.
- Image Processing: Please send unedited files. If necessary, we will adjust the size or crop details for you. If details are desired, please indicate the corresponding part of the image.
- References to illustrations are to be inserted in the body of the text: Fig. 1, Fig. 2, etc.
- We would like to make our journal as accessible as possible, and therefore kindly ask you to send us short image descriptions, which we will then include in the final layout.

### Captions

The image captions should follow this scheme and include all information. If information such as year or author is not disclosed, indicate this accordingly with (n.d.):

Fig. #: Artist, *Object/Title*, Date, Medium, (Measurements (in cm or mm, height before width)), Location, Collection, if necessary Copyright/URL.

Example:

Fig. 1: Diego Velázquez, *Portrait of Juan Martínez Montañés*, ca. 1635, oil on canvas, 109 × 107 cm, Madrid, Museo del Prado, © Museo del Prado, Madrid.

For illustrations from books please use this scheme:

Fig. #: Artist, *Object/Title*, Date, Medium, Measurements (in cm or mm, height before width), Location, Collection, in: bibliographic information according to [CMOS 18](#), if necessary Copyright/URL.
